- 1. The words "The Environmental Protection" (Prescribed Processes and Substances etc.) (Amendment) Regulations 1994" shall be deleted.
- 2. The words "<u>Date Variation Notice Served</u>; <u>15../11/2002</u>" shall be inserted below the "Date Authorisation Served" line.
- 3. The words "Moss Grove Service Station" shall be deleted and replaced by the words "Kingswinford Express".

The process description shall be varied as follows:-

- 4. The number 'five' shall be deleted and replaced by the number '3', with reference to the number of petrol storage tanks.
- 5. The words "The stage 1 petrol vapour recovery system was installed in 1996, the lines for stage II have been laid but have not yet been connected to the tanks or pumps.

The following variations have been made to the authorisation condition:-

- 6. Condition 1.2, the word "of" shall be deleted.
- 7. Condition 2.1, the number "4" shall be replaced by the number "2.2", the number "11", shall be replaced by the number "1.5".
- 8. Condition 2.3, the following words shall be deleted:-
 - "and under the circumstances detailed in condition 2.1, be advised to the Local Enforcing Authority immediately".
- 9. Condition 2.4, the words "at least 4 weeks before the modification is due to take place" shall be inserted afte the word "alteration".
- 10. Condition 3.8, the word "return" shall be inserted after the word 'vapour' on the first line.
- 11. Condition 4.1, the word "annually" shall be deleted and replaced by the words, "at least every 2 years".
- 12. Condition 4.2, the word "A11" shall be deleted and replaced by the word "Any".

A comma shall be inserted after the word 'pipework' in line 1 of this condition.

The words "or as otherwise stated in the site petroleum license" shall be added to the end of this condition.
