The Pollution Prevention and Control Act 1999 (PPC Act) introduced a new pollution control regulatory regime known as Local Authority Pollution Prevention and Control (LAPPC) which is gradually replacing the pollution control regime set up under Part I of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 (EPA 1990), under which you were authorised to operate a prescribed process. The most significant consequence of LAPPC is that authorisations to operate prescribed processes under EPA 1990 are to be replaced by Permits to operate Part B Installations.

As part of the transitional arrangements to introduce LAPPC you were deemed to have made an application to operate a Part B Installation under LAPPC on 1st April 2006. The Council has now determined this application is now issuing your Permit to operate a Part B Installation which is enclosed in this letter. The Permit has replaced your authorisation to operate a prescribed process under EPA 1990 which ceases to have effect.

I have now determined your deemed application to operate a Part B Installation and accordingly I am now issuing you a Permit to operate Part B Installation which has replaced your Authorisation issued under EPA 1990 and is enclosed in this letter.
